**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING  
BID AND AUTHORIZING CONTRACT  
WITH KNOBEL'S ELECTRIC, INC.  
(YAKIMA VALLEY HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNALS UPGRADE PROJECT)**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside has previously authorized commencement of the Yakima Valley Highway Traffic Signals Upgrade Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside has solicited sealed bids for such Project in compliance with applicable law and procedure; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest bid submitted by a qualified bidder is in the amount of \$114,434.00, excluding taxes per Revenue Rule 171, from Knobel's Electric Inc., of Yakima, Washington; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that acceptance of such bid and authorizing the City Manager to prepare and execute an agreement with Knobel's Electric, Inc. for the construction of the Project is in the best interests of residents of the City and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** That the bid in the amount of \$114,434.00, excluding taxes per Revenue Rule 171, submitted by Knobel's Electric, Inc. for the work of the Yakima Valley Traffic Signals Upgrade Project, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare, execute and administer an agreement for the construction of such work, all in accordance with plans and specifications for such project.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
