

INVITATION TO BID

RECEIPT OF BIDS

Sealed bids for the Drilling and Construction of Well #13 will be received for the City of Sunnyside, represented by the Department of Public Works, by the City Engineer.

Bids will be received at City Hall, South Entrance, West Door, 818 East Edison Avenue, Sunnyside, Washington 98944 until 10:00 AM, March 2, 2010, and shortly thereafter the bids will be opened publicly and read aloud in the Public Works Conference Room.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK

This project includes, but is not limited to, furnishing all labor, tools, materials, equipment, for the drilling and construction of Well #13 for the following:

1. Well to be drilled using open-hole mud rotary drilling to a depth of 300 feet.
2. Installation and sealing of 16-inch diameter production casing.
3. Drilling to final well depth of between 300 and approximately 400 feet using cable tool or reverse-circulation rotary with clean water.
4. Install 12-inch diameter telescope-size pre-pack screen to complete the well.
5. Test wells TW-2 and TW-3, and Production Well 5, will be decommissioned according to applicable standards. TW-3 will be used as an observation well during the Well 13 pump test, and therefore shall be decommissioned following completion of the testing program.

TYPE OF BID

Bid shall be on a firm unit price basis for each of the Bid Items identified in the Bid Form.

This on-line plan room provides Bidders with fully usable on-line documents, with the ability to: download, print to your own printer, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources (on-line print form), and a free on-line digitizer/take-off tool. The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds (Section 00600) and as described in Section 00700 - General Conditions.

No prebid meeting is planned for this project.

CONTRACT TIME

The Contract Time is defined in Section 00700 - General Conditions, and specified in Section 00500 - Agreement.

QUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS

Requirements concerning the qualifications of BIDDERS are described in Section 00100 - Instructions to Bidders.

OWNER'S RIGHT TO REJECT BIDS

The City of Sunnyside reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject bids.

FUNDING

Any Contract awarded under this Invitation to Bid is expected to be funded from revenues generated from SRF Funding and/or Water System capitol outlay to the work under this Invitation to Bid.
